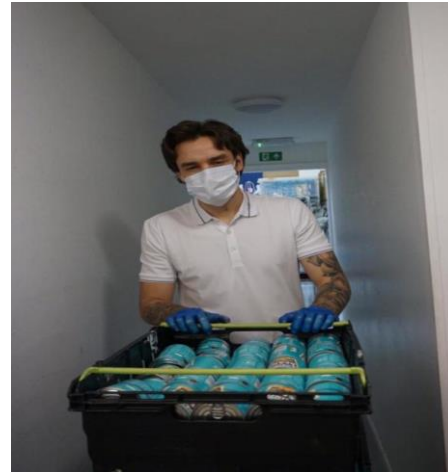

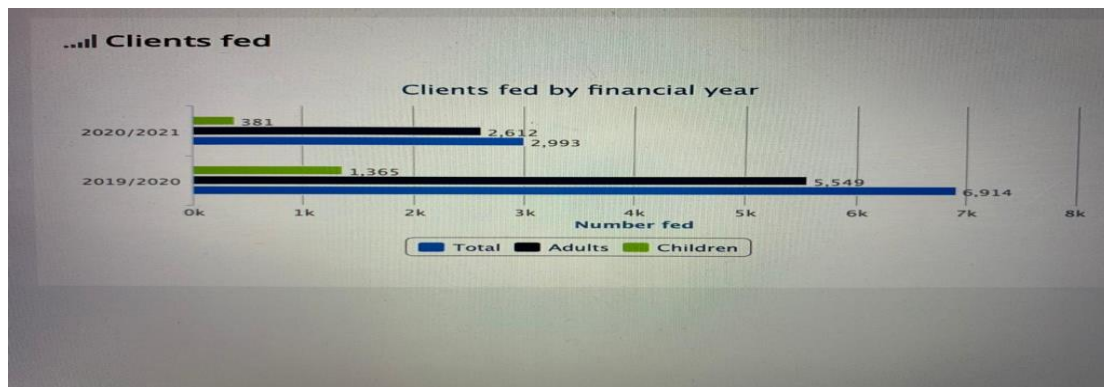
LIAM PAYN OF "ONE DIRECTION" VOLUNTEERED AT EUSTON FOODBANK

Food Bank Statistics 2019/2020 vs. 2020/2021



Euston food bank has in the last six months supported approximately 2,993 individuals, including 384 children. In contrast to the past six months, our data shows an increase of 958 people receiving support from the food bank. Though we have seen an increase in the amount of food items received this quarter compared to the previous, there has also been a spike in the number of people visiting the food bank. We anticipate this trend to continue as people are being laid off from their jobs due to the corona virus economic impact. Therefore, we project an increase in referrals as more people face uncertainty in their household incomes. Your donations will definitely make a difference.
